

The University of Music and Performing Arts Munich offers a diverse range of Study Programmes leading to different degrees.

Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Arts

Most instrumental and vocal study programmes at the University can be studied with a performance profile or a pedagogic profile. The standard period of study is eight semesters.

The following study programmes are exclusively offered with a performance profile: Choral Conducting, Orchestral Conducting, Historical Performance Practice, Composition, Composition for Film and Media and Church Music (Protestant/Catholic).

The following study programmes are exclusively offered with a pedagogic profile: Folk Music and Elementary Music Education.

Master of Music and Master of Arts

Almost all study programmes which lead to a Bachelor's degree at the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich can be continued as a Master of Music degree. The standard period of study is four semesters.

The Master Programmes in Voice (Concert/Art Song) and Voice (Opera/Music Theatre) follow on from an undergraduate vocal study programme.

The following study programmes are exclusively offered at Master's level: Voice Music Education, Jazz Education, Chamber Music, Art Song Interpretation, New Music.

The following study programmes lead to a Master of Arts degree: Cultural and Music Management, Music Journalism in Public and Private Broadcasting.

Postgraduate Continuing Studies („Meisterklasse" Certificate)

For graduates of a Master Programme or an equivalent academic degree, the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich is offering a „Meisterklasse" Certificate (continued specialisation studies). As part of these postgraduate studies, students have the opportunity to perfect their artistic skills studying with renowned teachers. The teachers are renowned experts in their subjects with extensive teaching experience. The standard period of study is two semesters, with an optional extension of two semesters upon the student's request. Candidates are required to pass an entrance examination for acceptance on the Programme. After successfully completing the Programme, students receive a Postgraduate Certificate („Meisterklasse" Certificate).

The following subjects can be studied as part of the programme (listing in alphabetical order):

Baroque Bassoon, Baroque Oboe, Baroque Viola, Baroque Violin, Baroque Violoncello, Bassoon, Clarinet, Composition, Double Bass, Flute, Fortepiano, Guitar, Harp, Harpsichord, Harpsichord (Historical Performance Practice), Horn, Jazz Clarinet/Jazz Bass Clarinet, Jazz Composition, Jazz Double Bass, Jazz Electric Bass, Jazz Guitar, Jazz Percussion, Jazz Piano, Jazz Saxophone, Jazz Trombone, Jazz Trumpet, Jazz Voice, Lute, Oboe, Organ, Piano, Recorder, Recorder (Historical Performance Practice), Saxophone, Timpani/Percussion, Transverse Flute, Trombone, Trumpet, Tuba, Viola, Viola da Gamba, Violin, Violoncello, Violone, Voice.
